### Job Description:

We are looking to hire a dedicated Elementary School Teacher to become part of our team in ReinventED Puenbo, and teaching students between the ages of 6 and 11 years old. The Elementary School Teacher will seek to accomplish our school's philosophy of education through instruction, design of learning projects and example, and provide learning that meet students' requirements, interests and capabilities. You will take precautions to protect students, equipment, materials and facilities, and keep accurate records in compliance with relevant laws, policies and regulations. You will collaborate with administration to create and implement rules and policies to promote appropriate behavior from students in school settings and strengthening individual student potential.

To ensure success you will have the ability to form interpersonal relationships with all your students and their parents, and take an interest in their well-being. Top candidates are caring, perceptive and proficient with organizing children.

Purpose: To design and implement strategies and actions that ensure the development of students' skills, through the implementation and evaluation of the plans and programs of the School's Educational Model.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Gets to know students individually and makes changes and adjustments in pedagogical practice based on needs, individual rhythm and talents.
- Carries out academic monitoring of students and supports behavioral monitoring, providing evidence of the achievements obtained throughout the school year.
- Prepares learning plans and projects focused on the development of skills, taking in consideration area of expertise and students' individual and group characteristics, needs, pace and talents.
- Evaluates process and progress in the development of students' skills.
- Meets with students and parents to discuss education-related issues, and attends staff meetings.

- Establishes a developmentally appropriate, positive, inclusive and safe learning environment that is conducive to learning.
- Advances positive interpersonal relationships with coworkers and students.
- Communicates proficiently and assertively with students, peers and school staff.
- Implements school-adopted curriculum, that includes Ecuador National Standards.
- Integrates suitable use of technology.
- Provides progress reports periodically.
- Determines and supports standards of classroom behavior, and harmonious relationships.
- Plans and supervises assignments and activities for student teachers, teacher assistants and volunteers as required.
- Applies, evaluates and provides feedback on the Educational Model of the School inside and outside the classroom.
- Support and develop student's autonomy.
- Recognize own autonomy level
